Katia Wish is a children's book author-illustrator based in Boston, MA. She enjoys creating her own stories as well as illustrating manuscripts of other authors.

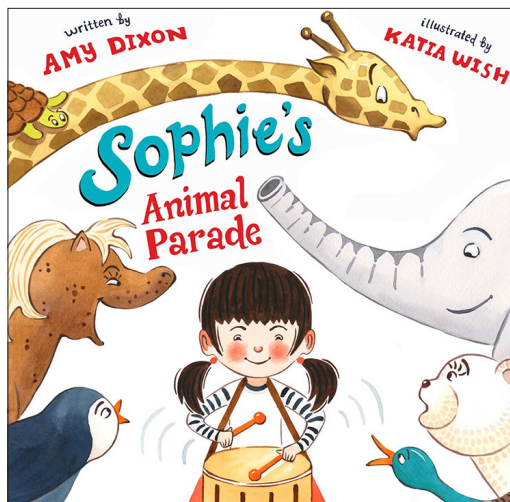
PROGRAM 1: AUTHOR-ILLUSTRATOR

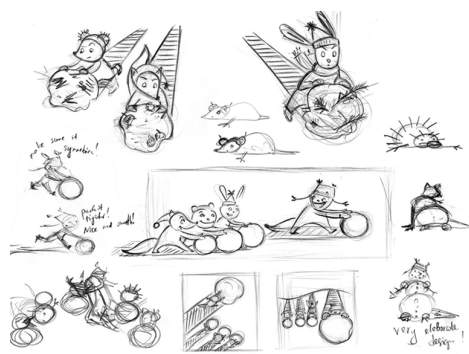

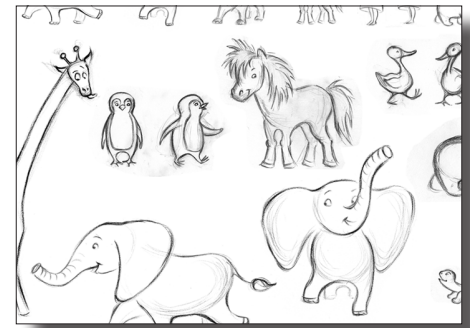
